

# WELCOME

**WELCOME** stands for Welsh Environmental Link **Creating Opportunities for Muslim Engagement.** 

This project aims to raise environmental awareness via lectures, discussions of Green issues, through sermons, seminars and is planning to run a climate change conference. It also actively encourages and initiates involvement in practical activities such as tree planting outings and conservational work.

### Red Café

Although Red Café first opened in 2001 new developments seem to be the order of the day! Sustainable development has long been one of the focal points of the project.



Red Café has been included as one of the sites on Swansea's Sustainability Trail and has begun to host workshops on Recycling, Food Miles and Fair Trade, engaging groups as diverse as Key Stage One Primary school children and women from ethnic backgrounds who are a part of Women in Action. The recent creation of a bar constructed entirely from recycled materials is a popular talking point within the community café, providing an opportunity to raise issues of sustainability informally.

Considerable effort has been put into re-cycling and facilities are now available for metal cans, glass, plastics, cardboard, paper, wood, garden waste, aluminium foil, electronic equipment and scrap metal.

#### What are Swansea's Faith & Spiritual Communities?

..Swansea and its surrounds have a rich diversity of Faith Communities including seven world religions: Baha'i, Buddhist, Christian, Hindu, Jewish, Muslim and Sikh. Swansea also has a thriving contemporary spiritual community which includes eco-spirituality, paganism, druidry, wicca, psychic and spiritual centres, shamanism, esoteric study groups and many holistic practitioners and therapists. On this Map we have called these the Holistic Spiritual Community. In addition to these there are also other smaller religious & spiritual groups.

#### What is the Holistic Spiritual Community?

...The Holistic Spiritual Community is the name given to the growing contemporary movement of people who do not feel tied to one of the traditional faith communities but take a more generalised approach to spirituality. They respect and welcome diversity of belief, and respect the core values and inspiration of the traditional faiths. #### Why was the Map created?

...the Faith & Spiritual Communities of Swansea hold a common belief that we all share one planet and have a responsibility to care for, respect and protect it for ourselves and future generations. This Map is a symbolic representation of that shared belief and commitment. It has been two years in the making and was inspired by the local Swansea Green Map project which was produced to help people do their bit to make Swansea a really sustainable place to live, work, and visit. Through simple local actions done together as one human family we can make a huge difference both locally and

Since 2001 many Heyokah Centre activities have taken place at a richly diverse area of land at Coed Bwlardd, where buildings with low environmental impact are being created using timber harvested sustainably from the woodland. Open days and workshops are held throughout the year providing opportunities for people of all ages and backgrounds to learn new skills, enjoy the natural environment, and often meet new friends. Several gentle paths have been developed for community access and Forest School activities. Bushcraft Weekends are also being encouraged. This work with the land results in conserving and enhancing this area.

Cornerstone Church is actively engaging in sustainable practices within their community through the development of an environmental policy.

These guidelines are to help promote environmentally friendly work practices at Cornerstone Church Centre

appropriate, printing on both sides of paper, use of scrap paper (supply in office) instead of post-its etc.

Reduction of paper consumption where

- Recycle paper rather than throw in bin (box in office).
- Monitors turned off when not in use. Lights turned off when not in use.
- Use of required amount of water when boiling kettle.

- Use of mugs and not disposable cups
- where possible Recycle ink cartridges and toners.
- Purchasing of goods that don't cause harm to the environment and fair trade products where possible e.g. recycled ink cartridges, fairtrade tea and coffee etc, environmentally friendly cleaning products, low energy light bulbs
- Use of mailing preference service to stop unwanted junk mail faxes
- Monitor use of heating system to reduce
- Organising removal of recyclable products to Penlan tip recycling centre inc Cardboard & Plastics
